- 8. Received into Orthodoxy today** by the Holy Mystery of Chrismation is Dennis Adam Francioli. Many years!

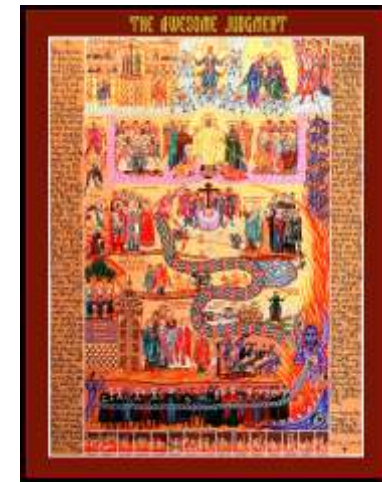
