- 4. Today is the First Sunday** of Great Lent. We use the Divine Liturgy of St. Basil; note that the priest's prayers are somewhat longer than in the Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom. Please note the change in the Censing Hymn, Antiphons 1 and 2, and the Lord's Prayer (see the music *Supplement*).
- 5. Christian Education session** will follow Divine Liturgy *today*. Topic: The Icon of Annunciation.
- 6. The Second of the Tampa Bay Area Lenten** Pan-Orthodox Vespers will be served today at St George Serbian Orthodox Church, 15250 58th St N, Clearwater, FL, at 5 pm. *"How good it is for brothers to dwell in unity."*
- 7. Divine Liturgy of the Pre-Sanctified Gifts** will be served on Wednesday, March 4, at 6:30 pm. A simple soup supper will follow.

- 9. Don't forget:** move clocks ahead one hour NEXT Sunday for the return to Standard Time.

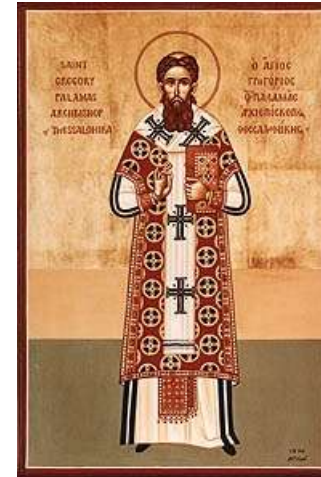
