The Royal Doors and the Deacon's Doors are kept open all during the Paschal season that ends on the Eve of Ascension. As the Altar area of an Orthodox Church is symbolic of heaven, so having the doors open during the Paschal season symbolically shows us that the Resurrection of Christ has cleared the way for our access to eternal life!
- 4. Panachida in Paschaltide** will be served today for the repose of the soul of Gregory Klymenko, father of Walter Klymenko. Eternal Memory! Christ is Risen!
